



Health & Safety Policy:

KiDiMu will follow state and federal guidelines as we have done throughout the pandemic and lift our mask policy on Saturday, March 12. At that time, wearing a mask will become voluntary for all Museum visitors, as well as KiDiMu employees.

Visitors may choose to wear masks for a variety of reasons, and KiDiMu will support the choice of our visitors and staff to wear or not wear masks while in the building.

Waiver:

An inherent risk of exposure to COVID-19 exists in any public place where people are present. COVID-19 is a very contagious disease that can lead to severe illness and death. According to the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention, senior citizens and visitors with underlying medical conditions are especially vulnerable. By filling out our visitor sign-in sheet you acknowledge that you understand and voluntarily assume all risks related to exposure to COVID-19 for all members of your group.

Facility Rules:

- Child supervision required. We ask that all adults remain within view of their child. We are not able to accommodate unaccompanied adults without an appointment.
- No child drop-off unless your child is registered for a program such as a camp, workshop, or preschool.
- No eating inside the museum.
- Shoes must be kept on, except in designated areas.
- All guests must check-in at the front desk before entering the facility.
- Rough-housing with exhibits and/or other people is not permitted.
- Disruptive, disrespectful and/or abusive behavior will result in your being asked to leave the museum immediately without refund, and may be grounds for revoking museum membership.
